## Tournament Rules

Normal FIH rules of hockey apply

Please respect your umpires at all time. Captains will need to make sure that their teams provide umpires as allocated on the schedule. Teams that do not provide their allocated umpires may have results forfeited. The schedule for Saturday's classification matches (including umpire allocations) will be published on the Friday once pool matches are determined. Thanks to all of our umpires but in particular Emma, Ferrett and Marc who have registered solely to umpire.

Outfield players may only play for their allocated team as shown in this pack. If teams need additional players they will need to have the Tournament Director's prior permission.

Timings are 10 minute quarters (except for the Mens Pool X which is 8 minute quarters). At the end of the first and third quarters there shall be an interval of 1.5 minutes. Half-time is 4 minutes. Penalty Corners awarded at the end of a quarter get played.

PinkHockey can amend the schedule as a result of any circumstances that may arise. Teams are not guaranteed any warm up time on the pitch and we need to fit in pitch watering as well.

Please clear all rubbish up after you and vacate the team benches as quickly as possible at the end of your match. We have a really tight schedule and need to keep to time.

In each pool, all the teams will play against each other with three points to the winner; one point to each team, in the event of a draw and no points to the loser. If at the end of the pool matches two or more teams have the same number of points for any place in a pool, these teams will be ranked according to their respective number of matches won. Then teams will be ranked according on goal difference and if there still remains equality among two or more teams, then these teams will be ranked according to their respective number of "goals for".

In a shoot-out competition we will be using the FIH Shoot-out regulations but only **three** players from each team take a one-on-one shoot-out.

For matters not covered elsewhere all discretion rests with the Tournament Directors whose decision is final.
